BowFlex HVT: Noises - Metallic grinding or scraping

Follow this troubleshooting guide to help resolve noise issues on the BowFlex HVT.

Some common complaints may include:


• Metallic grinding/scraping noises

Follow these steps to troubleshoot the issue

Tools you may need:

Phillips head screwdriver Flathead screwdriver 6mm hex/Allen wrench, or the wrench from the hardware card included with your machine


1. Inspect the brake disc for contact with the magnets. Remove the lower rear cover (**reference 1**) using a Phillips head screwdriver. The power inlet wire must be unplugged prior to fully removing the cover.

The screws to remove are circled in red. Unplug the power inlet wire (red/yellow circles) before completely removing the rear cove

2. Once the cover is removed, locate the brake disc and magnet (reference 2). The magnets should not be making contact with the brake disc. If they are making contact, check if the magnets have broken off of the brake arm (reference 3). If the magnets are broken off of the brake arm or continue to rub on the brake disc, order a Brake Arm Assembly [13939.A].

Inspect the brake disc (yellow arrow) and the brake disc magnets (red arrow).
